Mandatory Instructions

1. Participation shall be through pre-registration only; no spot registrations will be entertained.
2. **Students should produce their school ID (not emirates ID) to get their chest number.**
3. For the events (Talent show, National Anthem, Storytelling and Public speaking) an online screening process will be conducted. Participants must submit a 90-second performance video following the organiser's instructions within 2 days of receiving the registration mail. Only shortlisted candidates (those who passed the screening) can perform in the event.
4. The decision of the Grievance Committee will be final for all matters except those which are evaluated by the Judges.
5. Read the rules, instructions and judgment criteria before registration.
6. Decision of the Judges will be considered as final and non-binding.
7. MSS Organizing committee has the right to adjust the MAX participation count per event. This is subject to early registration received from the schools. The event registration spot allocations are based on first come first basis.
8. Winners will be announced the same day of the event, and every effort will be made to distribute the prizes on the same day during the closing ceremony.
9. Each participant can register up to three individual events in total.

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MSS Champions Trophy Interschool Quiz - Rules and Regulations

Grade 8 , 9 , 10 , 11 , 12

General Rules

1. The questions for the Quiz will be related to the theme – **“Together for Tomorrow – The Community Quiz, Exploring how shared purpose shapes our future”**.
2. School official team/pair with same school entries are eligible, and team shall consist of two persons (from Grade 8, 9, 10, 11, 12).
3. The participants shall not be allowed to use mobile or other electronic instruments.
4. The questions shall be in the form of multiple choice, True / False statement, Specific- answer questions etc.
5. Audience/Supporters shall not give any hints or clues to the participants/competitors.
6. Replacement of any participant of a team is not allowed after registration.
7. Parents are not allowed inside the preliminary round exam hall.
8. E-Certificate will be provided to all participants.
9. The decision of the Quizmaster will be final and will not be subjected to any change/appeal.

Preliminary Round

Each team would be given a set of question paper containing 25 multiple choice objective type questions.

Rules:

- Time limit - 20 minutes
- Only 4 Teams would be selected for STAGE ROUNDS
- In case of tie between 2 or more teams (within the 1st to 4th position), further 5 questions would be asked for final selection.
- For identification, **only** the Chest Number shall be written on the answer sheet.
- Answer key of the preliminary round will not be published.
- The selected teams shall have to appear for the final round.
- Chest Number must be worn and should be clearly visible.
- Participants must reach the venue at least **60** minutes prior to the competition and collect their Chest Numbers. **Students should produce their school ID (not emirates ID) to get their chest number.**
- Late entry will not be accepted, 5 minutes after the start of the competition, and no additional time will be granted for late arrivals.

Interschool Science Exhibition - Rules and Regulations (Grade 8 , 9 , 10 , 11 , 12)

Theme – “Smart Solutions for a sustainable community”

Encouraging practical innovations — clean energy, water conservation, waste management, health tech, Preserving food in a healthy way, recycling, — for real community impact.

1. School official team/pair with same school entries are eligible, and team shall consist of two persons (from Grade 8, 9, 10, 11, 12).
2. The exhibition will be held in two categories:
 - a. **Working models**
 - i. Defined as a representation of a particular phenomenon in the real world using something else to represent it, is functional in real time with moving medium or parts or components.
 - b. **Non-working models**
 - i. Defined as a representation of a particular phenomenon in the real world, is non-functional and has no moving medium, parts or components.
3. Students can participate in either of the categories mentioned above.
 - a. Both Teams from each school may participate in the same category or different category.
4. The size limit of the model or display piece should be within the given dimensions, ie **110cm * 75cm**.
5. Participants should bring their own stationeries/quick fix items if required and the same will not be provided at the venue.
6. Participants must reach the venue at 9 a.m and collect their Chest Numbers. **Students should produce their school ID (not emirates ID) to get their chest number.**
7. The venue will be open for participants to set up their models from **9am to 11am**.
8. Those who arrive late will lose their chance to take part in the exhibition.
9. Facilities will be arranged to provide access to electricity for working models if required, and the same should be notified by the students to the concerned coordinator one week prior to the event.
10. Models should be prepared and displayed by the participants only. Guided work will not be entertained.
11. The item should be an innovative and inexpensive design or technique.
12. (PS: Making use of biodegradable wastage will enable the students to secure bonus points).
13. A detailed note (in clear Printed Format), regarding the model should be displayed at the venue which should include the materials used, the overall concept, principle or process involved.
14. The exhibited model should be made available for public viewing until 4pm.
15. Judging and evaluation will be done based on
 - ✓ Student’s own creativity,
 - ✓ Originality,
 - ✓ Scientific thought,
 - ✓ Innovation
 - ✓ Technical skills involved and
 - ✓ Overall presentation of the project.

Note: Points allocated for Working Models will be higher in comparison to non-working Models.

16. The decision of the judges shall be final, and no discussion/appeal shall be entertained.
